 \sim Enrollment procedure to school in Japan \sim



(As of November, 2024)

[Elementary/Junior High school in Japan]

If you would like to enroll a child of foreign nationality at public elementary/junior high school, please complete the enrollment process so that the child can receive the same education as a child of Japanese nationality.

●Elementary/Junior high school period● In Japan, children enter elementary school in April following their 6th birthday, and they receive education for 6 years. After graduating from elementary, they go to junior high school for 3 years.

Financial assistance

If there is a financial difficulty attending school, there may be financial assistance for school supplies by applying through the school, etc. (No financial support will be provided if your income is high). Tuition fee/Text book

There are no tuition fee and text book fee for public elementary/junior high school. The school supplies and P.E. clothes should be paid.

●Support in Japanese at school●

If a child attends school in Japan for the first time, we dispatch a staff who can speak a foreign language (other than English). The child can receive the support twice a week for the first year, then once a week for the second year. Also, a Japanese teacher regularly come to visit from other school to teach Japanese.


<How to complete the enrollment process>

Please visit <u>School Support Division</u> at Kagayaki Plaza Kirara 4F with <u>residence cards</u> or <u>special</u> permanent resident certificates of both parents and child. Tell a staff that you need to complete the enrollment process for elementary/junior high school for your child. Then, fill out the application form.

Train

Get off at Makino (牧野) Station of Keihan Railway and walk about 20min.
